Play therapy is a therapeutic technique that uses children's unique language - play, to engage them in a multisensory, interactive process. It goes beyond traditional talk therapy, providing a safe, supportive environment for children to express themselves, develop life skills, and overcome challenges.

Play therapy fosters growth by acknowledging children's needs and beliefs, allowing them to become more authentic and integrated individuals who are better at responding to triggers and challenges.

Who can benefit from play therapy?

Play therapy is helpful for children between ages 3 - 12. Play therapy may be helpful in a variety of circumstances, such as:

- ADHD
- ASD
- Anxiety
- Attachment Issues
- Behavioural issues
- Bereavement

- Bullying
- Depression
- Family Separation
- Peer relationships
- Self-esteem and Identity Issues
